Highlights of 2023-24



International Yoga Day (योगा दिवस)

21st June, 2023

To promote mental well-being and physical health, BNBV observed International Yoga Day through a guided session on breathing techniques and foundational postures. Students were introduced to the philosophy behind yoga and its relevance in daily life as a practice for inner balance and focus. This initiative, which has been part of our wellness curriculum since 2015, reinforces our commitment to holistic education that nurtures both body and mind.

Raksha Bandhan (राखी) Celebration with XISS

31st August, 2023

In a warm continuation of cultural exchange, XISS students joined BNBV for Raksha Bandhan celebrations. The girls recited poems and shared traditional stories that highlight the symbolic value of the festival. These interactions create opportunities for shared cultural learning and help foster empathy, respect, and a collaborative spirit between students of both institutions.





Independence Day (स्वतंत्रता दिवस)

15th August 2023

The 77th Independence Day was commemorated at BNBV with a series of student-led performances and speeches honoring India's struggle for freedom. The day provided space for students to reflect on the relevance of historical movements in today's democratic landscape. The event emphasized critical engagement with history and celebrated the spirit of self-determination, a core principle echoed in our school's own mission to empower girls through inclusive education.



Shri Krishna Jnmaashtamee (श्री कृष्ण जन्माष्टमी)

6th September, 2023

The celebration of Janmashtami brought joy and creativity to the campus as students dressed up as Radha and Krishna, engaging with the rich mythological stories that are part of India's cultural heritage. Through role play and storytelling, students explored the values of compassion, courage, and justice associated with Lord Krishna's life.





Hindi Fortnight (हिंदी पखवाड़ा) Celebration with MECON Ltd.

18th September, 2023

MECON Limited organized a Hindi Fortnight celebration at our school, spotlighting the role of language in national and cultural identity. Students from BNBV participated in poetry, storytelling, and speech competitions conducted by MECON team members, while also presenting a cultural showcase. The involvement of corporate professionals, teachers, and guests helped bridge classroom learning with the real-world appreciation of Hindi as a medium of creative and civic expression. The event concluded with prize distribution and acknowledgment of students' enthusiasm and linguistic skills.



MOBILITY AND THE ROAD SAFETY FOR THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED PROGRAMME

A two-day training on mobility and road safety for visually impaired students was held at St. Michael's School, attended by twelve girls from BNBV. Conducted by trainers Mr. Pankaj Sharma, Mr. Irfan Ahmed, and Ms.

Sushma, the sessions focused on independent navigation, orientation techniques, and safety awareness in public spaces. This training builds essential life skills for mobility and autonomy, contributing directly to the girls' confidence and preparedness for real-world challenges. All participants received completion certificates, affirming their progress in self-reliant travel.





Republic Day Celebration with Xavier Institute of Social Service

26th January, 2024

On Republic Day, students from Xavier Institute of Social Service (XISS) collaborated with Brajkishore Netraheen Balika Vidyalaya to co-create a vibrant celebration of India's constitutional values. The program opened with a reflection on the significance of the day, followed by spirited performances from BNBV students in dance, drama, poetry, and music - activities they had rehearsed in regular workshops conducted by the visiting XISS students. This annual collaboration strengthens civic learning, artistic expression, and peer engagement across institutions. Founder - Neelu Verma - commended both sets of students for their dedication and emphasized the importance of such partnerships in enriching inclusive educational spaces.



Eye Health Screening Camp with Shreshtha Netra Chikitsalaya

7th February, 2024

Continuing our focus on preventive healthcare, an eye screening camp was organized in collaboration with Shreshtha Netra Chikitsalaya. Students underwent comprehensive check-ups and received medication where required. This partnership ensures that health remains an integrated part of our educational program and that students receive timely and professional medical attention as part of their residential support.





Saraswati Puja and Cultural Showcase with XISS

14th February, 2024

Saraswati Puja was celebrated on campus with students from XISS, who joined BNBV girls in a shared cultural event that honored learning and creativity. The day included music, dance, drama, and poetry performances—many co-created during regular engagement sessions facilitated by the XISS team. Chairperson Neelu Verma shared the school's vision of holistic education, which includes free schooling from elementary schooling to under-graduation, hostel facilities, and vocational training such as call centre preparation from Class 10 onward.



Meditation Workshop by Mrs Malvika Kanan

17th February, 2024

A guided meditation session was conducted by Mrs. Malvika Kanan, where students practiced hand movements, breathing exercises, acupressure techniques, and chanting. Framed within a broader conversation about mental clarity and emotional wellness, the session introduced students to mindfulness as a daily tool for concentration and calm. Incorporating such practices into school life supports a well-rounded development model rooted in mental resilience.





XISS Farewell and Sustainability- Themed Art Project

28th March, 2024

To mark the conclusion of the year-long engagement between XISS and BNBV, students came together for a creative workshop using natural and recycled materials to create artwork and crafts. The activity served as both a celebration of their shared journey and a reflection on sustainability and environmental responsibility. The day concluded with cake-cutting, musical exchange, and the distribution of fruits with a discussion on nutrition and well-being. The farewell underscored how this collaboration nurtured learning on both sides- students from XISS gaining firsthand experience in inclusive education, and BNBV students engaging in diverse enrichment activities that broaden their academic and social worlds.
