# Highlights of 2022-23









#### Cricket And Meditation Coaching Camp Organised By The Samarthan Trust For The Disabled

#### May 1st-3rd, 2022

In partnership with the Samarthanam
Trust for the Disabled, we hosted a
specialized coaching camp, commencing
on May 1, 2022. Designed to support
physical development, mental focus, and
self-confidence, the program included
adaptive cricket training, self-defense
workshops, and guided meditation
sessions.

- Day 1: The camp commenced with a welcome and orientation session, where students were introduced to their coaches and the concept of selfdefense.
- Day 1 (Afternoon): Participants were introduced to the basic laws of cricket, followed by hands-on training in batting and bowling techniques adapted for the visually impaired.
- Day 3: The session emphasized martial arts-based self-defense. Students learned key terminologies, techniques, and real-life applications for personal safety.

This collaboration reflects our commitment to providing a balanced education that supports both academic and personal growth.

# Oral Health Screening Camp

### August 6th, 2022

On August 6, 2022, an Oral Health Screening Camp was conducted on campus in collaboration with the Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Ranchi, The initiative aimed to promote preventive health care and provide professional dental services to our students. The camp addressed a range of dental issues, including replacement where required, underscoring the importance of holistic well-being as part of our residential program.







#### Pragya Teacher Training With Vision Empower

Dates: November 21-22, 2022

We were proud to host Jharkhand's first *Pragya Teacher Training Program* facilitated by **Vision Empower**. The two-day workshop brought together educators from three institutions, focusing on innovative, inclusive strategies for teaching Science and Mathematics to visually impaired students.

Key areas of training included:

- Activity-based learning models
- Numeracy through computational thinking (VICT)
- Integration of accessible digital tools such as the *Subodha App*

By investing in teacher development and partnering with organizations at the forefront of inclusive education, we continue to enrich the learning experiences of our students.




